

## Adventure, 5+: ROSALIE written and illustrated by Nina Dulleck (ISBN 60587, 96 pages)

- A keep-you-happy book for children to listen to or read by themselves.

It is Saturday morning, and Rosalie is bored. She's already had more than enough sleep, but Mum and Dad don't want to get up yet. "How about you going to get the rolls today?" Dad suggests. The baker's shop is a good two and a half houses down the road. She sets out together with the staircase elephant and the glitterfarting elf. She knows that with a good dose of imagination, she can get through any adventure.
