Jana Crämer, born in 1982, is an author, speaker and podcaster. With over a million followers on social media, she is one of the most powerful voices for self-love, mental health and eating disorders in the German-speaking world. She has experienced what she writes about: she went from being a fangirl to a music manager, weighed over 180 kilos, lived with binge eating disorder for over twenty years and felt trapped in a body that was constantly being judged. Today, she stands for honesty about herself and her diagnosis of lipoedema – online, on stage and in the podcast *Wir sind so (We are like this)*. Together with her best friend, musician Batomae, she has been touring schools across Germany for ten years as part of the BKK bauchgefühl initiative.

Jana Crämer was awarded the SignsAward18, the 'Oscar of the communications industry', for her courage in communication. In 2023, TikTok honoured her as 'BookTok Author of the Year'.


Sabine Ebert was born in Aschersleben, grew up in Berlin and studied Latin American studies and linguistics in Rostock. In Freiberg, her adopted home for many years, she worked as a journalist, wrote several non-fiction books and, in 1990, founded the city's first independent newspaper in a long time. Her passion for Saxon and German history led her to start writing historical novels, all of which became bestsellers. Her novels have been translated into several languages, and her debut, *Das Geheimnis der Hebamme (The Midwife's Secret)*, was filmed by ARD and premiered in a theatre adaptation by the Landesbühnen Sachsen.

For her work on her novels about the Battle of the Nations and the events that followed, 1813 - Kriegsfeuer (1813 - War Fire) and 1815 - Blutfrieden (1815 - Blood Peace), she moved to Leipzig.

She now lives in Dresden, where she wrote the *Schwert und Krone (Sword and Crown)* series about Frederick Barbarossa and the power struggles between the ruling houses of that era, as well as the novel about the Restoration period, *Die zerbrochene Feder (The Broken Pen)*.





"I have come to this office without merit." The new Pope Leo XIV uttered these humble and unusual words when he took office. When Robert Francis Prevost was elected Francis' successor on 8 May 2025, he was at least as surprised as the rest of the world. He was not among the top candidates, and hardly anyone outside his immediate circle had heard of him.

So who is this new pope, the first American to hold this office and a relatively young man? Will he follow in the footsteps of his predecessor, or will he find his own way of fulfilling his role? Vatican expert and bestselling author Andreas Englisch has been closely following four popes for almost forty years.

In his new book, he tells the exciting story of the conclave after Francis' death and sets out on the trail of Leo XIV, this hitherto little-known man. He finds companions, close confidants, family members and people at Leo's previous places of work in the USA, Peru and Rome who can give him insights into the life, faith and deeds of the new Pope. They all tell of a man who is truly as friendly, humble, conciliatory and quiet as he has shown himself to be in his first days as pope, a pope who, according to his own statement, wants to rule as an equal among equals.

Andreas Englisch's new book is the first biography of Leo XIV researched from close quarters and is full of surprising details. A must-read for anyone who wants to get to know the man behind the pope and understand how this quiet monk at the top of the power structure can change the Church.




Sebastian Fitzek is THE most successful German bestselling author, whose works have sold more than 20 million copies and have been published in more than 37 countries. He began his career in radio, later studying law and gaining a doctorate in copyright law. In 2006, he published his first psychological thriller Therapy, which became a bestseller, as did all subsequent books. Between 2014 and 2021, Sebastian Fitzek was the most successful German author of the year six times. In 2023, his books Die Einladung and Elternabend were the bestselling books of the year. Many of his books have been successfully adapted for film and television series, such as *Therapy* (Prime Video) as a six-part miniseries, which was a TOP 10 hit in seventeen countries for several weeks. Also, many of his works have been the subject of several theater adaptations, including Der Seelenbrecher, Die Therapie and Passagier 23. Sebastian Fitzek has twice been nominated for the Glauser Prize and has been awarded the Golden Lovelybooks Readers' Prize several times. He also received the Hörkules and won the European Prize for Crime Literature in 2016. He is an ambassador for the German Child Protection Association and patron of the association Das frühgeborene Kind e.V. Fitzek was born in Berlin in 1971. He lives with his family in Berlin.




Bestselling author Peter Prange is the great storyteller of German history.




