

Ünsal Arik



Ünsal Arik was born in Parsberg in 1980 as the son of Turkish guest workers. He had to fight all his life – against discrimination, professional failures, private low blows. But after all these defeats, he made a surprising comeback as a professional boxer with 13 championship titles. Arik became known to a broad public when he actively spoke out against the policies of Turkish President Erdoğan. Despite all opposition, his goal remains to be a role model for young people and to work for peaceful coexistence.

As a "Kanake" in the land of the "Almans", Ünsal Arık lives by the motto: all or nothing. He tries his hand at football, IT sales and insurance. But Arık doesn't find happiness in this and falls deeply, even slipping into homelessness. What finally saves him from ruin is boxing. He wins a series of international titles and embarks on his toughest mission yet: fighting against the authoritarian policies of Turkish President Erdoğan. Now Arık tells his whole story as he goes through life. Without compromise.

Ünsal Arık grows up in the Bavarian province and is torn between his Turkish parental home and his new German homeland. Despite his great talents, whether on the football pitch or in sales, his life plans fail time and again. Caught in a spiral of failures and private setbacks, Arık finally arrives at the bottom: Drug addiction, crime, homelessness. In the end, it is more by chance than plan that he takes up boxing and saves himself: With tireless fighting spirit and toughness against himself, he manages the unbelievable and becomes a professional boxer at the age of 30. And not only that, he fights for numerous international titles, including the IBF Intercontinental in the super middleweight division.

But his most important opponent is not in the ring, but on the political stage. Time and again, Arık makes political statements against the policies of Turkish President Erdoğan and is threatened in the strongest terms for this, also and especially by Turks in Germany. But Arık remains steadfast and says: "Only with mutual respect can integration in Germany succeed." And so begins his longest struggle to date.

From mobbing victim to motivator: Jana Crämer had a severe eating disorder, weighed almost 180 kilos just a few years ago and was mobbed for years. She took her life into her own hands and lost 100 kilos.

In his new book, bestselling author Andreas Englisch, who has met Francis many times and had the privilege of accompanying him on his travels, shows the challenges the Pope has been confronted with during his term in office so far and the reforms he succeeded in implementing despite all opposition. Sisters on the Move is a gripping mixture of family history, historical novel and contemporary history. Knowledgeable and with a lot of empathy, Sybille Schrödter also brings the eventful 1950s to life with the fate of the Danneberg family and their rum house.

Mothers and daughters in stormy times

Flensburg 1950: After the dark years of the Second World War, the whole of Germany is teetering between hope for a new beginning and new challenges, including the sisters Lene, Lizzie and Jette Danneberg. As head of the Danneberg rum house, Lene has to stand up to her own son, of all people, while the family business comes under increasing pressure. The politically committed Dörthe accuses the family of basing its wealth on slave labour; and Danneberg's cousins Klara and Frederike fight, as their mothers once did, to realise their own dreams.

Can the sisters keep their family together in these stormy times?


