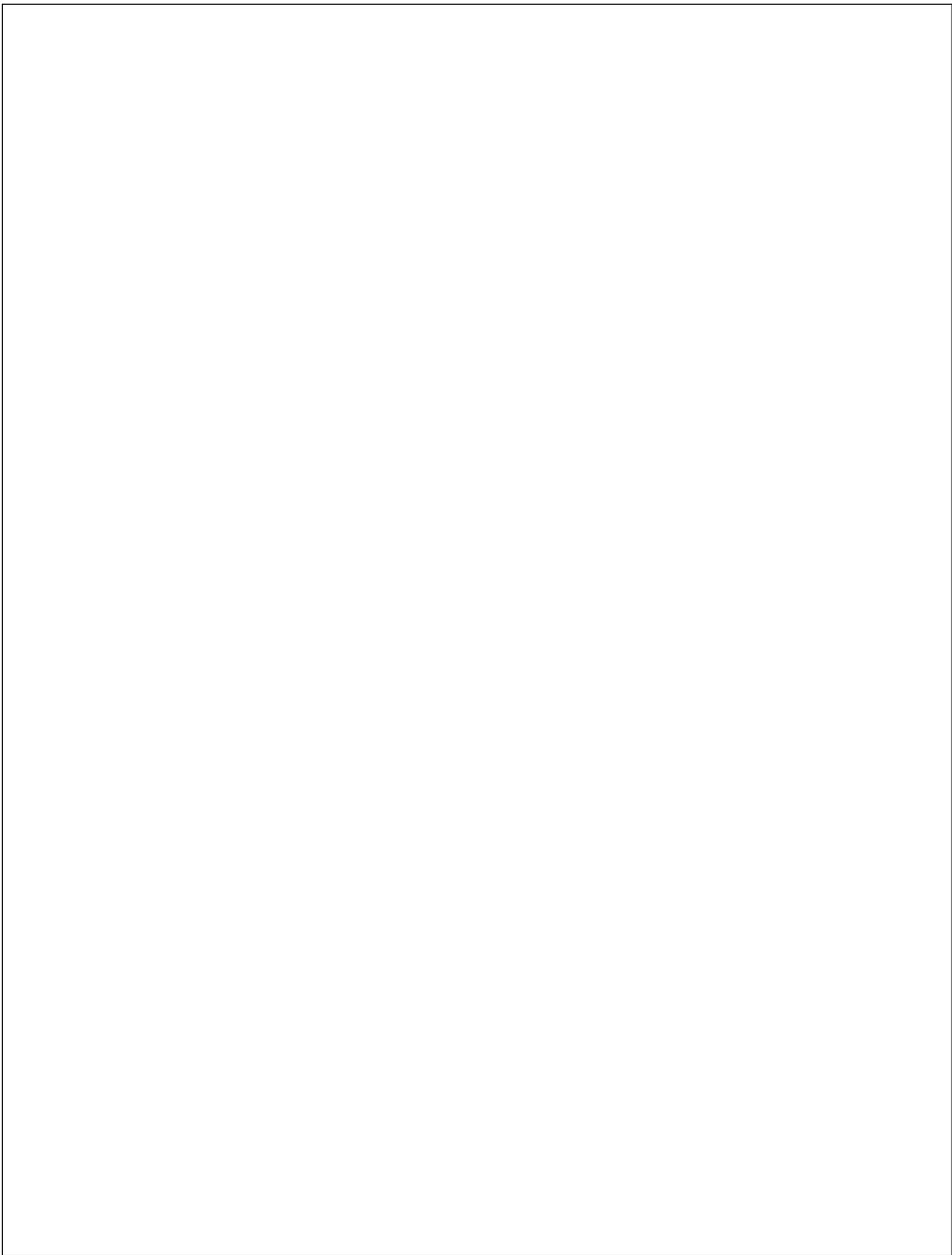





He is also the President of the Poetry Society (UK) and Poetry Editor at *The New Yorker*.

She was illiterate when she escaped and yet she went on to make a life as an artist, becoming friends with the likes of Frida Kahlo, Diego Rivera, and other leading artists and intellectuals in both Latin

America and Europe.

Emma Reyes died in 2003. 


